S 2130 (and A 1391)	Krueger, Addabbo, Hoylman-Sigal, Liu, Serrano	Requires additional disclosures from lobbyists, including: campaign contributions to elected officials by lobbyists and their clients and employees; existing business relationships or associations with public officials; and the names of family members of a public official to whom the lobbyist, or their employer, paid compensation of over \$500 in the preceding calendar year and the amount of compensation paid; provides for the disposition of campaign funds. S 2833	Breslin	Requires legislators and candidates for the legislature to provide a link to their financial disclosure statements on their official state and campaign websites which shall direct website visitors to current and past financial disclosure forms that the legislator has submitted. S 3452	Rivera, Serrano	Prohibits lobbyists who are convicted of or plead guilty to class D felonies or higher level crimes from acting as a lobbyist for a period of three years from the date of the conviction; provides the authority to extend suspensions; entitles such lobbyists to a hearing upon application for suspension extension. S 3507	Skoufis	Requires members of a regional economic development council to file financial disclosure forms.	Died in committee
S 3544-A	Breslin	Relates to electronic financial disclosures of legislative members and candidates. Requires the creation of an electronic version of a disclosure statement and directs COELIG to make available an editable, electronic, readable, and searchable version of the annual statement of financial disclosure by January 1, 2025. 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S 3606-A	Webb, Hoylman-Sigal	Modifies the term "reportable business relationship" as it relates to certain employees of SUNY and CUNY where their only form of state employment is with SUNY or CUNY.	Died in committee
